The successful candidate will be resourceful, creative, and detail-oriented, possess strong project management skills, and feel comfortable working cross-functionally at all levels of the organization.

- Create and release product and packaging specifications for new development, product updates, and cost reductions, accurately and in a timely manner
- Work closely with Product Engineering, Marketing, and Sales to develop new and innovative product & packaging concepts
- Proactively identify cost reduction opportunities; schedule and drive cost reduction projects to realized cost savings
- Support ECM process by providing timely and accurate master data as required
- Develop and implement test plans as needed
- Manage multiple projects simultaneously in a self-directed manner, working closely with Marketing, Operations, and domestic & international suppliers to ensure that all stakeholder needs are met
